

**INFORMATION EX ART. 13 REGULATION EU 2016/679 FOR SUPPLIERS****A. DATA CONTROLLER**

We inform you that, according to the Regulations EU 2016/679 ("Regulations") your Private Data gathered in order to handle the contract and to execute the law obligation will be treated by Bombardieri SPA with registered office at via Locatelli 2/4 24025 Gazzaniga (BG) Italy as Data Controller.

**B. KIND OF DATA**

The Controller will deal with the Private Data as they are defined by the Regulations gathered during the handling of the pre-contract and contract dealing among which there are, purely as an indication, your first name and surname, address, fixed telephone number and mobile telephone number.

**C. PURPOSES OF PROCESSING, LEGAL BASIS AND DATA PROCESSING OPTIONAL CHARACTER**

Your Private Data will be dealt with, without any need of your specific consent, in order to handle the pre-contract and contract duties and to fulfil the law obligations.

The data will be processed for the following purposes:

- rating of the new suppliers;
- dealing and execution of the pre-contract obligations;
- dealing and execution of the obligations deriving from the contract;
- supply of the main and/or additional services related to the contract;
- fulfilment of the obligations as per D.Lgs. 81/08 concerning health and safety at work, by way of example, information about members of your staff ( first name and surname, register, place and date of birth, date of hiring) allowed to operate in our firm and that must be in possession of a specific certificate attesting their qualifications both technical and professional beside their position INPS, INAIL and CCNL.
- execution and fulfilment of obligations set by regulations, laws and EU rules;
- dealing of contentious procedure;

The legal basis of the data consist in the execution of a contract or a pre-contract measures and in the fulfilment of a legal obligation. It is optional to provide your personal data but a refusal to do so will prevent us from fulfilling the contract.

**D. COMMUNICATION OF YOUR PRIVATE DATA TO THIRD PARTIES**

Your Private Data may be shared with:

- natural persons authorized by the Private Data Controller subject to signing a reserve agreement (i.e. personnel/management department staff, processing data operators);
- consultants, credit institutions for accounting/administrative purposes, business partners when the work or part of it is made by external firms that behave as responsible for the dealing of the data;
- parties, agencies or authorities when is mandatory to communicate your Private Data on the strength of law disposition or by order of the authorities;
- With regard to any transfer of the Data towards Third Countries, the Controller informs that the dealing of the data will take place in accordance with the conditions allowed by the laws in force, such as the consent of the interested party, the adoption of Standard Terms approved by the European Committee, the selection of parties that comply with international programmes for free data circulation (i.e. EU-USA Private Shield) or that act in Countries which are considered secure by the European Committee;

On request, the Controller will provide further information.

**E. KEEPING OF THE PRIVATE DATA**

Your private data will be kept for 10(ten) years. Yet it is stated that a longer keeping is possible when provided for by enforceable rules.

**F. SUPPLIER'S RIGHT**

Supplier is entitled to ask the Controller, at any time, to access to his Private Data, to modify or cancel it or to oppose its processing. Supplier is entitled to ask the restriction of the use of the Private Data as per article 18 of Regulations and to get a copy of his Private Data in a form that can be read by electronic devices, as per article 20 of Regulations.

In any way customer is always entitled to lodge a complaint with the Private Data Protection Authority, as per article 77 of Regulations, should he think that his Private Data are not dealt in accordance with the rules in force.
